All Scouts should wear their **Class A uniforms** and bring a **signed blue card** and a **merit badge book**. Scouts participating in both sessions should bring a bag lunch with them. There will be **food available** for purchase at the seminar! **If the scout does not have a signed blue card from his unit, he will not be able to complete the badge!**

Scouts need to have with them a copy of their current medical (parts "A" and "B") with them the day of the seminar. This is required to participate. Any scout who does not have their medical form, will need to provide it before they will be allowed to participate.

Personal Study Sessions are at the scouts pace and will be scheduled for the badges indicated. **Scouts who do not have all of the requirements completed will not complete the badge.**

There are no full day sessions at our seminar. The three Citizenship badges are offered in both a morning or an afternoon session, not both. Please indicate on the registration form if you would prefer morning or afternoon. Every effort will be made to give you your first choice in badges.

There is a limit of the number of scouts allowed to participate in each session. Depending on the badge, there will be a limit of 10 or 15 scouts per badge. The only badge with a different set limit is the E-Prep (limit of 12).

In case of inclement weather, every effort will be made to contact the scouts via email or phone as to the status of the seminar. Scouts are also encouraged to check our website @ www.bsa37.org for the most up to date status if inclement weather is called for. If the weather does cause the cancellation of the seminar on February 18th, it would be impossible to coordinate everyone for another date, for this reason, every effort will be made to have the seminar on February 18th.
